- ※ Applicants who graduated from universities abroad are required to submit the diploma(s) and transcript(s) that are notarized by either Apostille standards or the Korean embassy/consulate.
- ※ Submission Guideline for Academic Credential Verification of Overseas University: Any documents written in a language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English by a certified translator.
 - ① Apostille Convention Country: Submit the Certificate of Graduation and Transcript notarized by Apostille.
 - ② Other Countries (Not Apostille Convention Country): Submit the Certificate of Graduation and Transcript (as a proof of confirmation overseas educational establishment or consul confirmation) notarized by the embassy or consulate office of Korea in-country.
- ※ All documents must be submitted in original form. No documents will be returned. (We do not accept copies, scanned documents or documents sent by email.)
- ※ If you do not submit all documents by the deadline for the first and second application, you will be disqualified. (Please be careful not to submit incomplete or missing documents.)
- ※ The applicant is responsible for all the consequences of submitting incorrect or omitted information.

■ Introduction of Studies

1. Theology

Theology major consists of <Theology> that deals with the whole area of theology for those who prepare for ministry and missions. Specializations include <Biblical Theology>, <Theological Theology>, <Practical Theology>, <Missiology>, and <Musicology>.

2. Leadership
